Important dates to remember for voting in the November 6 General Election include: • The deadline to register to vote for the November General Election is October 15. • The deadline to apply for a ballot by mail is 5 p.m. on Tuesday, October 30. • In-person absentee voting is available Monday through Friday 8:30 to 4:30 , and on Saturday, October 27 and Saturday, November 3 ; 9:00-5:00. • The deadline to vote absentee in-person is Saturday, November 3. • The deadline for a general registrar to receive an absentee ballot by mail is by 7 p.m. on Election Day, November 6.

The Officer of Election training will be October 29 at the Independence Fire Department. Sheriff Vaughan will give a presentation on more security measures. Our IT Manager Carl Caudill is excellent and keeping track of updates from Department of Elections. Veris has a new two factor authentication for secure access.

No further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next meeting will be October 11, at 3:00 in the Electoral Board Office.
