Mrs. Osborne brought the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. in the Electoral Board Office. The return materials and unofficial results were checked as each Chief Officer brought them to the Electoral Board Office. The meeting was adjourned, to resume at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday, November 6.

The Canvass of votes for the November 5 General Election resumed for Virginia Senate, House of Delegates, Commonwealth's Attorney, Sheriff, Commissioner of Revenue, Treasurer, Board of Supervisor At Large, Member of School Board At Large, Supervisors of Oldtown and Providence Districts and Soil and Water Conservation Directors, New River District. No provisional votes were received.

The Canvass was completed at noon. The Abstracts were completed; one copy was delivered to the Clerk of Courts; one copy was given to the General Registrar to be sent to the State Board of Elections; one copy was retained, with the originals, for the records of the Electoral Board. The work of all officers was complete.


No further business, the meeting was adjourned. The next meeting will be announced to be held in the Electoral Board Office.



Mrs. Osborne brought the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in the Electoral Board Office. The Minutes were read and approved from September 9, 2019.

A review of the Logic and Accuracy testing of the voting machines was done. The Voting Machine Techs were efficient and all work was complete.

Absentee Voting began September 20 with a moderate turnout.

The Officer of Election list was reviewed for confirmation of enough poll workers and alternates. Follow up was assigned to complete all confirmed. The OE Training was discussed for October 21 including instructions on a double sided ballot, review of opening and closing the DS-200 and Express Vote machines, general procedures, security and safety at the polling precincts.

The trailer to transport vote machines was reserved from Horizon Rentals in Woodlawn. The County is providing a vehicle and driver. The Vote Techs will be assisted by a checklist and map.


